
# Country comparisons: big God or big Self/closeness to God




### Study 3. USA

657 people in the USA were asked whether their relationship with God focused mainly on understanding God (big God), or if it focused mainly on understanding themselves (big Self).


Here are the results. Why do you think these groups had these views about their relationship with God?






#### Study 3. UK

297 people in the UK were asked whether their relationship with God focused mainly on understanding God (big God), or if it focused mainly on understanding themselves (big Self).


Here are the results. Why do you think these groups had these views about their relationship with God?






#### Study 3. India
