
NATRE SURVEY 2019: KEY FINDINGS

NUMBER OF SCHOOLS FLOUTING RELIGIOUS EDUCATION RISES



In almost 40% of community schools pupils are not receiving the Religious Education they are entitled to at Key Stage 4 (16 year olds).
