
What do we know about Secondary RE trainees in 2020-21?



Only **32%** of the 633 trainees have a degree in Religious Studies, Theology or Theology and Religious Studies. This makes the government funded subject knowledge enhancement courses important for recruitment. **36%** of RE ITT trainees from ITT Census 2020/21 completed a SKE course.
